## COMPETITIVE COACHES' LETTER OF INTENT

Anyone wishing to submit a **Letter of Intent** to be a head coach of a TSC comp team for the next seasonal year 2010-2011 should submit their letter by e-mail to the TSC President or the Comp Director (email addresses are available at titusvillesoccer.com). **The deadline for submitting Letters of Intent is April 30, 2010.** After which, an Executive board meeting will be held to discuss and vote on all submissions. In your Letter of Intent, please state what age group and gender (girls or coed) you wish to coach. Also, please include your years of coaching experience, age appropriate licensing (including certificate numbers), and any other volunteer experience at TSC. If you have any questions in reference to the age appropriate license that should be held, you may refer to the TSC Handbook that is available on line at titusvillesoccer.com or you may contact Chuck Beitel, Comp Director, at 268-2722 for any question that you may have.
